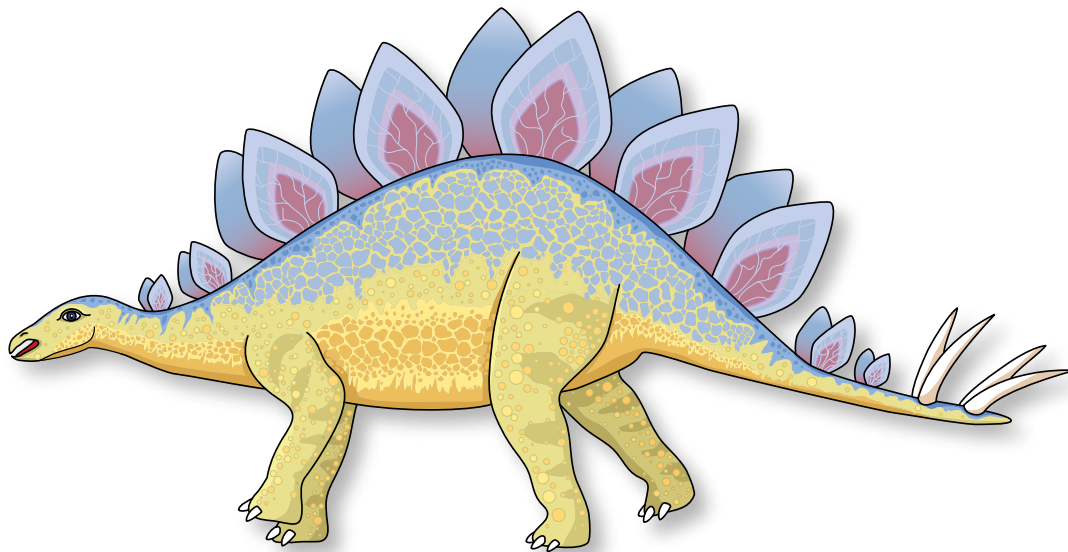


Stegosaurus



Stegosaurus

Length: 20 to 30 feet (6 to 9 meters)

Weight: 8,000 to 10,000 pounds (3,600 to 4,500 kg)

Habitat: North American woodlands

Diet: Herbivore (plant eater)

Fossil Discoveries: Colorado, Wyoming, Utah, Montana, South Dakota, Oklahoma

Features: Stegosaurus was slow moving and probably not aggressive. It had two rows of plates extending along the length of its back that were used for display or heat control. Its head was very small in proportion to its body. Its tail had pairs of spikes approximately two feet long that could have been used for defense or display.
